GUIDELINES FOR PUPILS

Appearance

Pupils are to be smart and their hair is to be tidy. Extreme hair cuts and extreme dyed hair will not be permitted, girls long hair to be tied back off the face. Girls with pierced ears may wear gold/silver studs or small hoops (one only in each lobe). Boys are not permitted to wear any skin piercing jewellery. No other visible body piercing is allowed. Excessive use of make-up and coloured nail varnish are not permitted during the school day.

Detentions – Senior School

Pupils may be put into detention by a member of staff for breaking school rules or breaking the rules of good behaviour. Weekday detentions take place on a Tuesday, Thursday and Friday between 4.00pm to 4.30pm, for minor offences. Friday Detentions are issued by the Head of Year who will contact parents, and take place as follows:

Level 1 – Friday 18.00-19.00

Level 2 – Friday 18.00-20.00

Detentions – Wilberforce

Pupils may be put into detention by a member of staff for persistent unsatisfactory prep, failure to complete prep, breaking school rules, or breaking the rules of good behaviour.

Detentions take place as follows:

Level 1 – Friday 18.00-19.00 in Wilberforce

Level 2 – Friday 18.00-19.00 in Wilberforce

Weekday detentions take place on a Friday at 12.30-13.00 for minor offences.

Failure to attend detention places the pupil in the next detention level. Pupils are to be in school uniform. Parents are informed if pupils have to attend a Level 1 or 2 Saturday detention.

Substances not permitted

Alcohol and cigarettes are strictly forbidden. Any pupil found in the possession of, or involved with, alcohol or cigarettes will face serious disciplinary measures. Any pupil involved with illegal drugs may be permanently excluded from Seaford College. The College Alcohol, Drug and Smoking Policies are sent to parents and are available in the Staff Centre. Copies are also available from the Headmaster's Office.

Items which are not permitted

- Chewing gum
- Aerosols
- Knives
- Fire Arms, BB Guns, Fireworks or any other offensive weapons
- Catapults

School Property

Pupils will be held responsible for any damage they cause to school property. Any breakage / damage must be reported to a member of staff.

GUIDELINES FOR PUPILS

Mobile Telephones – Senior School

Pupils may bring a mobile telephone to school on the understanding that they are not permitted to use their telephones during lessons or in public places during school hours 8.25am – 5.30pm.

Mobile Telephones – Prep School

Pupils may bring a mobile telephone to school provided it is first registered in writing with Mr Stather and on the understanding that they are not permitted to use their telephone during school hours 8.25am-5.30pm.

Please ensure that all mobile phones brought into school are insured. The school cannot accept any responsibility for loss, damage or theft and they are not included on the personal effects insurance.

Students' Cars

Members of the Sixth Form may use their own cars to go to and from the College. A car registration form must be completed and returned to the Deputy Headmaster.

Day pupils' car keys are held in the Senior Management Team office when the car is not being used. No other pupils may be transported in the car unless written permission has been given by both sets of parents. Pupils who do not conform with the school requirements can expect to lose the use of their car.

GUIDELINES FOR PUPILS

Behaviour

Pupils are expected to maintain proper standards of courtesy, punctuality and dress, and to be sensitive to the needs of others within the College. Bullying will not be tolerated. Any pupil who wilfully causes distress to another pupil and continues to do so may be excluded from the school.

At Seaford we promote:

- Respect and consideration for others (pupils, staff and the wider community).
- The right to live and learn in an ordered and ethical community.
- Care for the environment.
- The welfare of all people in our community.
- Good manners and a high standard of appearance.
- Self-discipline.

Uniform

Correct uniform must be worn during school hours, 08.25 to 17.30 Monday to Friday. Pupils must come to school and go home in full school uniform.

Shoes, not trainers, must be worn at, to and from school. The proper kit must be worn for PE.

Fire Safety

If the alarm bell sounds in a building you are in or if you see a fire:

1. Raise the alarm.
2. Immediately evacuate the building by the nearest exit, ensuring that no-one is left in the room.
3. Close all doors behind you.
4. Go to the assembly point and remain quiet while check is taking place.
5. Keep away from the building and do not return until the all clear has been given by a member of staff.

Whole School Evacuation

If the alarm siren sounds:

1. Raise the alarm.
2. Immediately evacuate the building by your nearest exit.
3. Go to the Sports Hall and congregate in designated year group area.
4. Stand in your tutor group and remain quiet while check is taking place.
5. Remain in Sports Hall until told to return to school by a member of staff.

Eco-Sense

1. Turn off computers at the end of the day.
2. Switch off lights when they are not needed.
3. Use paper sparingly and recycle.
4. Consider the school environment and use the bins provided for litter.
5. Think globally, act locally.

CONCERNS

Do you need to talk to someone who will listen to you?

If you feel you have been harshly or improperly treated, either by an adult or by another pupil, or if there should be any other cause for concern or worry, or if you think something is very, very unfair, **you should always ask for help. You can go to talk to:**

- Your Tutor
- Your Head of Year
- Your Housemaster/Housemistress/Resident House Staff
- Any member of staff you trust
- The Sister
- The School Chaplain
- The Deputy Head
- The Headmaster

Or, if you feel you need to go outside the school, then the **School Doctor** would be happy to see you.

If you have a worry, if you are upset, or if you have a concern, it is always better to discuss it rather than “bottle it up”.

There are plenty of people who will help you.

Houseparents/Tutor/Head of Year or the Headmaster are the most obvious and closest to hand, but you will find others equally willing.

If you feel you need a “private talk” ask for a quiet word with a member of Staff on your own. You should always also feel free to contact your parents at any time, but if the problem is to do with the school, try to talk to someone here first.

There is always someone who will listen and be able to help.
